

**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-06**

**Victor Valley Community College District**

**NON-RENEWAL OF EDUCATIONAL ADMINISTRATOR CONTRACT OF EMPLOYMENT (DEAN OF INSTRUCTION – SCHOOL OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY) FOR THE 2025/2026 ACADEMIC YEAR; APPROVAL OF REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY REASSIGNMENT TO THE DIRECTOR OF INSTRUCTION – NON-CREDIT INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS POSITION FOR THE 2025/2026 ACADEMIC YEAR.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to California Education Code Section 72411, the Board of Trustees (“Board”) for the Victor Valley Community College District (“District”) may elect to employ, reemploy, terminate, and/or not renew any educational administrator assignment in the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board may elect not to renew a Contract of Employment for an educational administrator assignment, with or without cause, by providing the educational administrator concerned with written notice of non-renewal prior to March 15 of the academic year in which the employment contract expires; and

**WHEREAS**, the Superintendent/President recommends that the Board not renew certain assignments for the 2025-2026 academic year, including, but not limited to, the educational administrator assignment of Dean of Instruction – School of Public Safety and Industrial Technology (PSIT), without cause; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board agrees with the recommendation of the Superintendent/President and desires not to renew the Contract of Employment for the educational administrator assignment of Dean of Instruction – School of Public Safety and Industrial Technology (PSIT) for the 2025-2026 academic year, which non-renewal shall be without cause; and

**WHEREAS**, in compliance with Education Code Section 72411, notice of such non-renewal shall be provided to the educational administrator on or before March 15, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the educational administrator concerned has requested voluntary reassignment to his former educational administrator assignment of Director of Instruction – Non-Credit Instructional Programs upon the expiration of his current Contract of Employment, which is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the Superintendent/President recommends that the Board approve the request for voluntary reassignment to the educational administrator assignment of Director of Instruction – Non-Credit Instructional Programs for the 2025-2026 academic year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board agrees with the recommendation of the Superintendent/President and desires to approve the request for voluntary reassignment to the educational administrator

assignment of Director of Instruction – Non-Credit Instructional Programs for the 2025-2026 academic year.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Trustees for the Victor Valley Community College District, as follows:

1. Consistent with Education Code Section 72411, the Board has elected not to renew the Contract of Employment, without cause, for the educational administrator assignment of Dean of Instruction – School of Public Safety and Industrial Technology (PSIT) for the 2025/2026 academic year.
2. The Board delegates authority to the District Superintendent/President, or his designee, to provide notice of such non-renewal by March 15, 2025, and to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this item.
3. The termination of the educational administrator assignment of Dean of Instruction – School of Public Safety and Industrial Technology (PSIT) shall become effective on July 1, 2025, following the expiration of the current Contract of Employment.
4. Consistent with Education Code Section 72411, the Board has further elected to approve a request from the educational administrator concerned for voluntary reassignment to the educational administrator assignment of Director of Instruction – Non-Credit Instructional Programs for the 2025-2026 academic year, which assignment shall become effective on July 1, 2025.
