**National Native American Heritage Month**

Jennifer Tarpley, the following resolution is hereby adopted.

**WHEREAS**, the first American Indian Day was celebrated in May of 1916, and more than seven decades later President George H.W. Bush in 1990 signed a joint congressional resolution designating the month of November "National American Indian Heritage Month; and

**WHEREAS**, in October of 2013, President Barack Obama issued a proclamation declaring November as National Native American Heritage month; and

**WHEREAS**, Native Americans have played a critical role in the health and vitality of our great Nation, and continue to contribute to our community, state, nation and world, including advances in education, medicine, art, culture, public service, economics, military, human rights, and politics; and

**WHEREAS**, National Native American Heritage Month is a time to honor their vibrant and diverse cultures, traditions and histories, and to acknowledge the important contributions of Native American people.






